ARTIST BIO

Lisa Levart is a photographer on a mission. Based in the Lower Hudson Valley, she has traveled extensively creating iconic portraits that uncover the spirit of ferocious women, powerful warrior activists and epic elders.

Levart's work was a finalist in the Julia Margaret Cameron Award's for Women Photographers, as well as the recipient of the 2023 Larry Salley Photography Award and the prestigious Brigit Award from the Association for the Study of Women and Mythology. Her photography has been exhibited widely— from galleries to museums, and is represented in the permanent collection of the 9/11 Memorial Museum in NYC.

Rooted in myths and sacred stories, her archetypal images weave together the personal and collective journeys of women's lives. Inspired by the collaborative process, her process makes space for personal agency, and the radical act of each woman declaring, "I am here. See me."

Her first book, "Goddess on Earth: Portraits of the Divine Feminine", won a Gold Nautilus Book Award and was named one of the 100 Best New Women's Spirituality Books by the California Institute of Integral Studies. "Goddess on Earth Oracle, A Divination Deck and Guidebook With Spirited Wisdom From Your Sisters" won a Nautilus Book Award in 2021.
